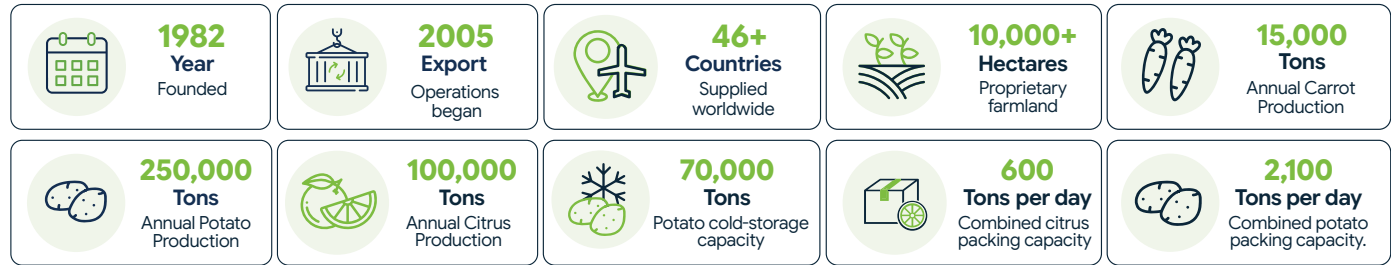

EGAST manages large-scale agricultural operations across Egypt's fertile Nile Delta and surrounding production areas, including dedicated citrus orchards, Pest Free Area potato farms and company-managed carrot plantations.

Direct farm management gives EGAST greater control over crop planning, cultivation practices, field supervision, harvest timing and product consistency.

Our agricultural teams combine generations of farming knowledge with modern crop-monitoring methods to support responsible production and reliable export programs. Advanced irrigation practices, field monitoring and responsible land stewardship support efficient resource use.

One Integrated System

EGAST connects each stage of the fresh produce journey within one coordinated operating model. This allows our teams to protect product condition, maintain traceability and prepare every shipment according to buyer and destination requirements.

Farm-to-market process

1



Cultivation

Products are grown through controlled farming programs supported by crop-specific field management and quality supervision.

2



Harvesting

Harvest timing is planned according to product maturity, condition, destination and confirmed supply requirements.

3



Sorting and Grading

Products are inspected and classified according to variety, size, appearance and buyer specifications.

4



Packing

Fresh produce is packed through specialized lines using formats suitable for retail, wholesale and industrial programs.

5



Pre-Cooling and Cold Storage

Temperature-controlled handling helps preserve freshness and product integrity before loading and shipment.

6



Quality and Documentation

Final checks, markings and export documents are aligned with market and destination requirements.

7



Container Preparation and Export

Products are loaded and prepared according to the confirmed shipment program, followed by export coordination and buyer support.

From field to container, every stage is connected.

Premium Egyptian Potatoes

EGAST supplies premium Egyptian potatoes grown in certified Pest Free Area zones and selected for consistent sizing, clean skin, dependable quality and suitability for fresh and processing markets.

EGAST owns and manages potato farms across the eastern and western sides of the Nile Delta, with potato production supported by more than 14,000 acres of sandy soil. Modern agricultural practices are applied from planting and crop management to harvesting, post-harvest handling, packing, and storage.

EGAST's potato packing methods use advanced handling equipment and product-appropriate packing systems designed to reduce damage and protect quality through storage and export preparation.

Egyptian Citrus, Prepared for Global Markets.

EGAST's citrus operations combine large-scale orchards, controlled harvesting, advanced sorting, specialized packing, pre-cooling and temperature-controlled storage. Products are selected according to color, freshness, taste, juice content, appearance and export-grade requirements. Our citrus infrastructure is designed to support reliable seasonal programs across retail, wholesale and food-service markets.

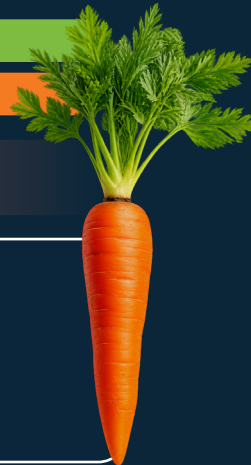

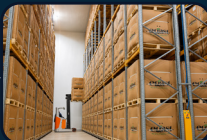
